Practice adding cents to make a dollar			
Practice taking a number value and converting it into cents (ie. 69 cents what coins can we use to make that value?)			
Split into three groups			
Station #1- uses a worksheet for students to practice Using coins to make different purchases (fake money required)			
Station #2- using fake money to practice different ways of making a dollar			
Station #3- worksheet to practice adding the value of images of different coins			

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Check for Understanding: (10 minutes)	
Understanding is checked while students are at each station and guidance/one on one instruction is provided when needed	
Groups called back to carpet to reflect together about the stations (self assessment)	
Exit ticket: (question at the end of the slideshow is presented) - students answer on sticky notes before they can move on to the next activity
